Footnotes

BENT TUNE stalked four wide, bid three wide in the second turn, vied for the lead, rallied and prevailed. QUIET APPROACH raced between rivals early, vied from between rivals in the backstretch but weakened and held place. MY CHOICE raced between rivals early, moved to the rail in the second turn, showed a mild rally and finished evenly. BLACKCOMB RUN was slow early, raced to the outside, rallied upper into the stretch and gained ground. THINKIN POSITIVE stalked the pace from three wide, raced evenly, rallied into the upper stretch but weakened. PURE FIRST lacked early speed, saved ground, rallied three wide into the stretch and gaining ground in the stretch. ARGENTUNE stalked the pace from three wide, raced evenly, rallied five wide but flattened out. VISION OF ROSES stalked the pace evenly on the rail, rallied in the upper stretch and finished evenly. SPECIAL GREY GHOST lacked speed, saved ground and was no factor. FATHER JONES broke sharply, dueled on the rail, vied for the lead in the backstretch but weakened and tired in the third turn.
