WILD YOUNG COWBOY raced evenly on the rail, gained steadily, dueled in the stretch and prevailed. WOOD B NICE lacked speed, raced evenly, advanced steadily, made a bid at the quarter pole, dueled in the stretch and closed. HURRICANE TIKI was slow early, raced evenly, gained ground in the backstretch, rallied and finished evenly. FIVEPINS stalked the pace, evenly ans showed a mild rally. LONGBOAT KEY saved ground, raced evenly, chased the pace and gained late. KHRUSHCHEV trailed then advanced steadily rallied but flattened out in the stretch. SAMMY'S VOW raced evenly close up to the to the outside but dropped back along the backstretch. TOP BREW raced three wide early, led in the backstretch but weakened and dropped back. AFTERNOON EXPRESS, pressed the pace on the rail but weakened in the backstretch and tired in the stretch. ILLEGAL WHISKEY raced six wide early, contended then dropped back to chased the lead. BLUE BAYOU saved ground, contended early but weakened in the backstretch, dropped back and was eased. DISCREET COMMANDER raced four wide early, stalked the lead but weakened after the half, gave way and was eased.
