**Footnotes**

COOL VENTURA lacked speed, gained ground steadily, rallied three wide into the stretch and drew clear mid stretch. BAD BIG AL raced evenly to the outside, gained ground then rallied three wide into the stretch and finished well. INUIT FISHER raced four wide early, pressed the pace then made a bid in the second turn, dueled in the stretch but weakened in the upper stretch. DIAMOND DOC dueled, outside, weakened upper stretch, faded stretch. FATHER JONES raced evenly to the outside, gained ground in the third turn, rallied three wide and closed the gap. TOBY BAY was slow early, raced evenly to the outside, rallied three wide for a late gain. FOOTPRINT dueled on the rail but weakened near the quarter pole and dropped back. SMILE N WAVE broke sharply but dropped back early and was never a factor. BEAU BRASS was slow early, saved ground and dropped back in the backstretch and trailed. MONSOON RAIN saved ground early, raced close up but weakened in the backstretch and gave way.
