NO TIME FLAT wide early, stalked pace, loomed 1 mile, weakened 1/4 pole. SIR DEUCES rail, steady advance backstretch, evenly. REGAL ABILITY rail, dueled, weakened 1 mile, faded stretch. REGAL RANDY dueled, outside, weakened backstretch, dropped back. GO GO TOMMY JOE slow early, evenly, passed tiring rivals. REEYRE slow early, evenly, no factor. TOPWYNSON wide early, evenly, dropped back. SILENT SHOES saved ground, evenly, dropped back backstretch, gave way.
