Footnotes

FOOTPRINT saved ground, vied for the lead early, stalked the lead then bid in the second turn, dueled to the inside of GANDOLF rallied into the stretch and prevailed in a hard drive. GANDOLF stalked the early pace, made a bid in the second turn, led briefly then dueled to the outside of FOOTPRINT but was outfinished in a game drive. OOKASHADA was four wide early, stalked the lead to the outside, bid three wide in the backstretch but weakened and finished evenly. AMAZIN BLUE saved ground, raced close up, gained ground along the backstretch, entered the stretch three wide stretch and finished evenly. RAGE TILL DAWN was unhurried early, raced evenly, got through on the rail in the upper stretch but flattened out in the stretch. GREENWOOD MEADOW saved ground and raced evenly. WEATHER WARNING broke sharply, dueled with FOOTPRINT, opened a short lead in the second turn but dropped back to stalk the lead and weakened and dropped back after the quarter pole.
