TOCCETIVE lacked speed, ran evenly, steady advance, rallied three wide, and closed well. DOUGS BUDDY set the pace, rallied into the upper stretch, vied all out but was outfinished. DEVIL IN DISGUISE saved ground, stalked evenly, got through on the rail, vied all out but weakened late. BEAR'S TAURUS raced evenly, gained in the backstretch, rallied in the upper stretch but, faded. UP JUMPS A MONSTER rail, stalked the pace, bid, rallied in the upper stretch but was outfinished. OFFICER JONES trailed, raced evenly and showed a mild rally. SPEYSIDE rail early. dueled but weakened and, dropped back steadily. CLEAR THE RUNWAY rail, dueled, weakened backstretch, gave way.
