### Footnotes

HIGHLAND HANNA rushed to contend, stalked three wide, bid three wide in the stretch and closed steadily. BRADY'S TOMBOY dueled on the rail, rallied in the upper stretch but was outfinished. BAY MOON raced three wide into the first turn, ran evenly, gained in the second turn, rallied three wide and closed. SWEET ESTEEM rushed to contend, pressed the pace to the outside, rallied into the stretch but weakened. MAGIC FLUTE raced close up on the rail, showed a mild rally and flattened out. SUN RUNNER raced evenly on the rail and flattened out in the stretch. MINT CHOCOLATE lacked speed, was forced wide in the first turn, gained ground, rallied four wide and finished well. DISGUISE THE LIMIT drifted out entering the first turn, ran evenly and was never a factor. ROYAL APPEAL raced evenly to the outside, weakened in the second turn and dropped back. OPIE DOKIE was slow early then forced wide entering the first turn, dropped back and trailed.
