Footnotes

CINNAMON N GOLD broke well, vied on the rail, edged ahead in the second turn, rallied into the stretch and drew off. BRAD'S BROTHER stalked the pace, bid four wide in the second turn but dropped back to finish second best. DIPPER'S APPEAL contended on the rail, gained ground in the second turn and flattened out in the stretch. WISEWOOD BOBBIE vied between rivals, weakened in the upper stretch and faded. LAKE ELIZABETH vied three wide, weakened after the quarter pole and raced evenly in the stretch. MOCHA SUPREME was slow early, raced evenly and was no factor. KASSOULASLASTSMILE raced four wide into the first turn, ran evenly but weakened in the second turn. WEEKEND TRADE lacked speed and trailed throughout.
