BOOMTOWN BRAT pressed the pace to the outside, bid and dueled after the quarter pole, rallied and drew clear in mid stretch. POINTS ALERT set a pressured pace on the rail, dueled after the quarter pole but weakened in mid stretch and finished second best. WHAT'S UP DOC bobbled at the start, stalked the pace to the outside, rallied three wide and closed the gap. MR. INSTIGATOR raced wide early, drifted into the first turn, gained ground, rallied four wide in the stretch but weakened. CASANOVA KING saved ground early, gained in the backstretch, rallied into the stretch but weakened. SHACKLES N CHAINS stalked the pace on the rail but weakened and dropped back in the second turn. MY BOY BEN lacked speed, trailed early and was no factor. GO DASHER was off slowly, saved ground early but dropped back in the backstretch and was distanced and eased.
