BEAR'S TIGERETTE broke in the air, trailed, gained ground in the second turn, rallied five wide and closed steadily. HARDCORE CANDY drifted in the first turn, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide, dueled, led late but failed to last. KOKOPELLI WIND raced three wide early, pressed the pace, dueled in to the stretch, led in mid stretch but weakened. CALMCOOLN COLLECTED stalked the pace on the rail, weakened in the second turn, rallied four wide and finished evenly. THAT VOODOO YOUDO set a pressured pace, dueled into the stretch but weakened in mid stretch. HONORARY GIRL lacked speed, saved ground and was never a factor. IBEGYERPARDON raced three wide into the first turn, stalked the pace but weakened after the quarter pole and tired.
