Footnotes

ELECTION VOW two path early, gapped, closed in after the half, was up close by the three quarter mile mark, cleared to the lead and finished well. NEARLY NORMAL was on the three path early, gapped out near the back of the field, staying the three path gained in the last turn and was up for place. TEN EVEN was racing the three path, gapped out early, gained ground in the backstretch, closed strong but was out finished for place. FERN VALLEY LANE raced near the back early, gapped from the leader, chased, closed ground in the last turn. I'M A BUBBLE TOO saved ground, was gapped early, closed in after the half, then was up close on the rail, moved to the three path for the stretch drive then hung mid stretch. SIR TIME was away alertly, opened up to lead to the three quarter mile mark, started to weaken and tired late. FRESH START trailed most of the race and was never a threat.
