SMILE AGAIN TERRI pressed the pace to the outside, made a bid in the second turn, dueled in the stretch, finished all out to prevail. SHES AWAY was slow early, advanced steadily on the rail, made a bid in the second turn, dueled in the stretch and prevailed. MATCH MISCONDUCT was slow early, raced evenly, rallied three wide and finished well. CASCADE PARK broke sharply, raced evenly on the rail, gained ground in the second turn and finished evenly. ALITTLE BLACKMAGIC set a pressured pace on the rail but weakened after the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. MISS BUTLER raced three wide into the first turn, gained ground in the backstretch, stalked the pace but finished evenly late. ABBEY'S APPEAL raced five wide into the first turn, dropped back and was no factor. L'TL ISOTOPE was slow early, raced between rivals, rallied four wide in the upper stretch but faded. PEASEPORRIDGE was caught four wide entering the first turn, dropped back in the backstretch and trailed..
