**Footnotes**

INDOCTRINATION broke well out of the gate, pressed the pace, drew clear in the backstretch and finished strong. SLEWEY raced between rivals, rallied in the upper stretch and finished well. SEVEN DIMES stayed on the rail,stalked the leaders,weakened in the backstretch, finishing evenly. TULLY B stalked while on the outside, weakened in the backstretch, made a rallied in the stretch and was gaining. BOLD AND WORTH IT had no speed, raced on the rail, rallied in the last quarter and gained ground late. SCOTIA'S MYST showed no speed, raced on the outside and made a mild bid. CRUZENFORCHICKS was three wide in the first turn, racing evenly while on the rail, was close up to the leaders but faded in the stretch. GRAN KASEKI was three wide in the first turn, raced evenly until the turn for home then faded in the stretch. JUKEBOX JACK was slow early, dropped back and trailed early. BIG STEP broke well, dueled, weakened at the quarter pole then gave way in the stretch.
