Footnotes

EYE SCAREY dueled to the outside of LITTLETRAPPER led at the quarter pole and drew clear in the stretch. LITTLE TRAPPER dueled on the rail, led but weakened at the quarter pole, but faded. INCLINED TO RUN saved ground, contended, raced evenly but weakened stretch. THINKIN POSITIVE saved ground and showed a mild rally. SLEW O TROUBLE raced three wide into the first turn, stalked the pace, raced evenly but weakened after the three eighths 8 pole, and flattened out. STARPONE lacked speed, raced evenly on the rail. FERION SKY was forced wide entering the the first turn, dropped back and was never a threat. A TAD DEVINE drifted out entering the first turn, dropped back and trailed. HIGH TOWER stalked the lead from between rivals but weakened in the backstretch. CERTAINLY A DOC lacked speed, raced evenly to the outside and dropped back.
