### Footnotes

TEJANO TROUBLE was taken back early to chase the leaders on the rail, gained ground steadily, made a bid four wide in the backstretch, led at the quarter pole and drew clear into the stretch. PROSPECT BEGONIA was caught four wide early, gained ground steadily, bid four wide in the third turn, rallied three wide and finished second best. CANDID REMARK lacked speed, raced evenly, rallied six wide in the upper stretch and finished well. ALABAMA RAIN chased the leaders from between horses, raced evenly, entered the stretch five wide and finished evenly. PICKINONTHEOLBANJO was four wide early, vied for the lead from three wide but weakened in the third turn and faded. SHACANE was three wide early and dropped back to race evenly, rallied four wide into the stretch and gained ground. BAD HAT saved ground, raced evenly, rallied four wide into the upper stretch but faded. FATHER JONES vied for the lead from between rivals, weakened in the third and dropped back. HOWSITGOINGHOTSHOT vied for the lead on the rail but weakened near the quarter pole and gave way.
