Footnotes

THE CON IS SMILES raced evenly to the outside, gained in the third turn, rallied three wide and closed steadily. AWESOME A. J. chased the pace on the rail, closed ground, opened a lead in the upper stretch but was outfinished. FREEDOM'S HALO dueled to the outside, led after the three eighths pole but weakened in the upper stretch and finished evenly. WEE BILLIE WILDE saved ground, raced evenly, made a mild bid but weakened in the stretch and finished evenly. DIVINE DEED was caught three wide early, ran evenly, gained ground in the backstretch but flattened out. PIER TWENTYONE was off slowly and trailed, rallied three wide and finished well. HIGH BODGIT lacked speed and was never a factor. OTTOSHINE saved ground, raced evenly but weakened in the third turn and gave way. GRANITE POINT dueled on the rail, weakened in the backstretch and dropped back steadily.
