Footnotes

PASSION RED broke sharply, set a pressured pace, rallied and finished well. JACOBS KISS stalked the pace, gained ground, got through twice on the rail but weakened. BRED ROYAL raced three wide in the first turn, ran close up, bid in the second turn but flattened out in the stretch. KOOL ATLANTIC raced evenly to the outside, rallied four wide and gained. GIN FIZZ was caught wide in the first turn, raced close up but faded in the stretch. RATTLE THE CAGE raced evenly on the rail, rallied three wide but faded. SIBERIAN COCKTAIL raced three wide in the first turn, ran evenly, rallied into the upper stretch but flattened out. WESTERN WOODS lacked early speed, saved ground, entered the stretch three wide but dropped back. DUAL FUEL lacked speed, trailed and was never a factor.
