BEAR'S SAGA saved ground, close up, gained steadily in the second turn, rallied in the upper stretch and closed well. CLEVER DISGUISE saved ground, set a pressured pace, weakened in the upper stretch but held well for the place. MARTINISATTHEWIRE pressed the lead to the outside, weakened in the upper stretch and finished evenly. LION EXPRESS saved ground, stalked the pace, bid three wide in the second turn, rallied four wide in the stretch and gained ground. I'M FOXY was slow early, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn and gained ground. MALEKIN saved ground, bid in the second turn, rallied five wide in the upper stretch and faded. WHITE SPEC was three wide in the first turn, raced evenly and was no threat. TIPPA JOE was slow early and showed little. HI TOPPER raced between horses early, dropped back and trailed.
