LONE STAR SLEW set a pressured pace on the rail, bid and dueled in the second turn, rallied and held well. HOWSITGOINGHOTSHOT stalked the early pace, bid and dueled after the quarter pole, rallied but was outfinished. BABS MOOSSA raced three wide early, gained in the backstretch, rallied three wide and closed the gap. COUNTDOWN AT CAPE raced three wide into the first turn, gained ground in the backstretch, rallied into the stretch but weakened. BENEZIT was slow early, gained in the second turn, rallied three wide but flattened out. LAKETON saved ground, raced evenly but weakened in the second turn. MAD WIN saved ground, raced close up but weakened in the backstretch and finished evenly. EL FIERO pressed the pace on the rail, weakened at the quarter pole and dropped back. SELIMAN lacked speed and trailed, drifted in the second turn and trailed.
