PROJECT FIFTY FIVE raced evenly on the rail, gained steadily on the rail, rallied into the stretch, closed fast and drew clear late. BOULDER HAT vied on the rail, drew clear in the second turn, drew clear but weakened and finished second best. ELM CREEK was slow early, raced evenly, rallied four wide and closed. TWOFOURTIME chased the leaders, ran evenly, showed a mild rally and finished evenly. BAD HAT was slow early, saved ground, gained ground in the second turn, rallied five wide and finished evenly. GHOST PIRATE broke sharply, vied three wide but weakened after the three eighths pole and dropped back. REMOVE vied between rivals, weakened entering the second turn and gave way.
