**Footnotes**

A SHAKY START rail, gaining backstretch, 4 wide 3/8 pole, drew off stretch. LOT A SMOKE stalked pace, evenly, gamely stretch, held place. TO DREAM AGAIN close up, evenly, bid 3 wide 3/8 pole, outfinished for place. JESSIE GUEST slow early, steady advance 3rd turn, rallied, finished well. AUDIO EXPRESS away alertly, set pace, weakened 1/4 pole, evenly stretch. JADEBQUICK rail, evenly, gaining backstretch, flattened out stretch. COME BACK MADELINE rail, evenly, passed tiring rivals. TANGO GIN wide early, evenly, weakened backstretch, dropped back. DEVIL WOMAN slow early, no factor, dropped back. VOLUNTEER ANNIE rail, close up, weakened backstretch, gave way 3rd turn.
