SPEEDY EYES dueled to the outside, led in the second turn, rallied in the stretch and drew clear. KYLA'S PRINCESS raced evenly on the rail, gained in the second turn, rallied and finished well. TIN LIZZIE raced evenly while close up, made a bid at the quarter pole, rallied three wide but faded in the stretch. ESTEEMS GOLD was used early, drifted entering the first turn, stalked the pace but weakened in the second turn. CIMMARON SKY lacked early speed, raced evenly and was never a threat. MARIACOMO raced three wide in the first turn, ran evenly, rallied four wide but failed to menace. BELLY TAP dueled early along the rail, weakened in the second turn and gave way LANAREE stalked the pace but gave way and trailed .
