PICK A PLACE was off slowly, raced evenly gained ground steadily, bid in the third turn, rallied into the stretch and closed. CAESAR RULES stalked and bid three wide, rallied but weakened in the stretch. TAME THE TIGER saved ground, contended, weakened in the third turn and faded. A PROMISE MADE raced evenly on the rail, evenly, rallied four wide and gained ground. BATTLE RIVER vied on the rail early, weakened after the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. WILFLO lacked speed, trailed and was never a factor. I'M QUICK INDEED vied to the outside. weakened after the quarter pole and dropped back. HUNGARIAN CHOOCHOO was slow early, saved ground and trailed in the stretch,. THE TRACK CONDITION WAS CHANGED FROM GOOD TO FAST.
