### Footnotes

WHIPPER WIND lugged out after the start, rushed to contention five wide, dueled to the outside of NEEDLESTICK, drifted out entering the stretch and drew off. ACCEPTED PUNCH was taken back early, saved ground, rallied in the upper stretch and finished well. MARKET MANIA raced evenly to the outside, chased the leaders, rallied in the upper stretch and finished well to prevail for place. NEEDLESTICK lunged at the start, dueled on the rail but weakened late in the second turn and faded. MORE SALT PLEASE drifted out entering the first turn, gained ground from three wide and flattened out in the stretch. LADY TIGER was three wide entering the first turn, chased the leaders in the backstretch and was no factor. BROOKE'S HONOUR lacked speed, was distanced and was pulled up in the stretch.
