VICTOR MAN vied for the lead from three wide, dueled in the backstretch, drifted entering the stretch rallied and drew clear. TAYLOR'S TALE chased the lead on the rail, rallied into the stretch, got through on the rail and finished well. RAVALIN'S RAEZAR raced three wide into the first turn, chased the leaders, jumped tracks in the upper stretch and finished evenly. BIG O PUCK STOPPER saved ground, vied for the lead, dueled in the backstretch but weakened in the upper stretch. KIMMICKI raced evenly to the outside, chased the leaders but flattened out in the stretch. DOUBLE TOT was away slowly, brushed the gate, lacked speed and trailed. WONDERFUL KING stumbled at the start, drifted out entering the first turn, dropped back and trailed.
