WAR OF THE RANGES rushed to the lead, set the pace, drew clear in the second turn . AIRO FAITH stalked the pace on the rail, dropped back in the second turn, rallied into the stretch and held place. SLEWS ACADEMY raced evenly on the rail, rallied into the upper stretch but flattened out. CONSTABLE SHEPPARD was off slowly, raced three wide in the first turn, gained ground, rallied six wide and closed. IN FORMATION was in tight and bumped after the start, contended to the outside, raced evenly, rallied four wide and gained. OVERBAY contended on the rail, gained ground steadily, got through on the rail into the stretch but faded late. STEELOFADEAL was in tight quarters early and bumped, saved ground then rallied four wide but faded. BARON VONSPEED raced between rivals early, dropped back and was no factor. SQUIGGLY GETS EVEN raced three wide into the first turn but dropped back and trailed.
