SMILE N WAVE saved ground, raced evenly, rallied three wide in the upper stretch and closed fast to get up at the wire. SALT FLAT SPEED dueled on the rail, opened a lead in the upper stretch but weakened and just failed to last. INUIT FISHER dueled to the outside of SALT FLAT SPEED, weakened in the upper stretch and faded. BAD BIG AL stalked the pace on the rail, rallied in the upper stretch and finished evenly. PROSPECT BEGONIA was slow early, raced evenly and showed a mild rally. ROLLETTI saved ground, raced evenly, failed to rally and flattened out in the stretch. TOBY BAY lacked speed, raced to the outside, entered the stretch three wide but was no factor. FOOTPRINT trailed, showed little. DIAMOND DOC contended to the outside, raced evenly but weakened in the second turn and dropped back.
