Footnotes

BILLYREA good start, stayed on the rail, was up tight, stayed close in the backstretch, pushed with a three wide move, led mid stretch and held well. DANCING DREAMER was away alertly, led, dueled into the last turn and held well for show. SEATTLE CYPRESS rated in behind the leaders, stayed on the rail, was close, went up the rail for the stretch drive, looked good but weakened mid stretch but held on for show. IRISH TWIST rated on the outside, stalked, edge up to duel into the last turn and weakened late. TURF ELITE took back, trailed and never got in contention. ROWDY RENEGADE took back, was four wide in the first turn, moved to the rail in the second turn, chased, was gapped at the half and was no real factor. STRIPEFACEGUY was away slow, hurried three wide early, rated three wide, was two wide in the backstretch, up to stalk, weakened by the three quarters and tired.
