Footnotes

TAKINGAFLYERONHER broke sharply to set the pace, drew clear in the backstretch, rallied into the stretch and finished evenly. EYE PRINCESSPRETTY chased the lead on the rail, gained ground in the second turn, rallied and finished well. CAPITINA was off slowly, raced evenly, gained ground steadily on the rail but weakened and flattened out in the stretch. THIS B JEWEL was off slowly, raced between rivals, gained ground in the backstretch but flattened out. CHINA DOLL chased the lead to the outside, ran evenly but weakened in the upper stretch and faded. COMEGETSOME lacked speed, raced evenly and passed faltering rivals. SUPPOSE A ROSE angled in at the start and was unruly, raced three wide in the first turn, moved to the rail in the backstretch and faded. MARK OF GOLD lacked early speed, raced evenly on the rail but dropped back steadily and was no factor. CASCADE PARK broke inward at the start, stalked the pace to the outside but weakened in the backstretch and gave way.
