HOLLYWOOD DREAMS stalked the pace to the outside, gained ground in the second turn, made a bid in the upper stretch and drew clear. MR. SHADAR lacked speed, raced evenly, rallied three wide, rallied and got up for place. TINY GIANT dueled to the outside, opened a lead in the backstretch but weakened in the second turn and faded. COOL KAHUNA saved ground, raced evenly and was no threat. COMMANDING ACE chased the pace on the rail, rallied in the upper stretch, got through, finished well. POINTS ALERT rushed to contention on the rail, dueled on the rail but weakened in the backstretch and faded. AIRO FAITH raced evenly to the outside, dropped back in the backstretch and trailed. DIAMOND DOC bobbled entering the first turn, broke stride and lost the rider.
