TWO HORN UNICORN stalked the pace on the rail, made a bid entering the third turn, led at the quarter pole, rallied, duel in the stretch and prevailed. SUNHAVEN raced evenly to the outside, made a bid three wide in the second turn, dueled in the stretch and prevailed. TOPASANNAH saved ground, raced evenly, closed ground in the third turn, rallied and finished well. TRISHAS EVEN got away alertly, dueled on the rail, led in the backstretch but weakened near the quarter pole and faded. EXECUTIVE CHEYENNE raced evenly on the rail, gained ground in the third turn, rallied into the stretch and finished evenly. SQUIGGLY GETS EVEN raced close up while three three wide, weakened in the third turn and flattened out in the stretch. SILVERHAVEN was off slowly, trailed and was never a no factor. MALAKWA raced four wide early, ran evenly but gave way in the backstretch. SHIFTY TIME broke sharply, dueled on the rail but weakened in the backstretch and gave way. THE 1 MILE FRACTIONAL TIME WAS HAND TIMED.
