AGAINST THE TIDE lacked speed, ran evenly, gained ground in the third turn, rallied three wide into the stretch and prevailed. DOUBLE SHUFFLE stalked the lead from three wide, bid late in the backstretch, dueled with FEEL THE MOMENT but weakened in mid stretch. QUIET APPROACH raced evenly on the rail, gained ground in the third turn, rallied three wide and finished well. FEEL THE MOMENT raced wide early, stalked the pace to the outside, made a bid late in the backstretch, dueled but weakened in the upper stretch and faded. WIRED TWO TWENTY raced four wide early, moved to the lead but weakened after the quarter pole and dropped back. KENNINGTON saved ground, raced evenly, failed to rally and dropped back. RONOHI, stalked the pace on the rail but weakened in the backstretch and gave way.
