PEAKNATACAT vied outside, stalked, was two wide stalking, between rivals to get lead at the half and held well. WASKASOO CREEK was four wide early, close to the pace, went to two wide in the backstretch, made a three wide move closed and was second best. SMART N SEXY raced from the rail, close up, even in the backstretch, edged over for the stretch drive but was third best. JIM N PEG'S GAL stayed near the back, trailed early backstretch, went up the rail in the last turn to get a small prize. LITTLE TRAPPER raced mid pack, followed staying on the rail and went four wide for the stretch drive. DUDE LIT led from the rail, led into the backstretch, gave up the lead at the half and weakened at the head of the stretch. SMILE AGAIN ANNIE trailed early, was near the back in the backstretch, chased the field and passed tiring rivals. SCOOT FOR LOOT took the three path early, stayed up close, was three wide in the backstretch still close to the lead and tired in the last turn.
