QUIET APPROACH raced evenly on the rail, gained steadily on the rail, opened a lead late in the third turn rallied and drew clear. PURE FIRST was slow early, raced to the outside, gained ground steadily on the rail, rallied and finished second best. DUAL FUEL lacked speed and trailed, gained ground steadily then rallied five wide and finished well. ALARICO was off slowly, saved ground, steady gain on rail in the backstretch, rallied four wide and gained ground. TOBY BAY raced evenly to the outside, gained in the backstretch but flattened out. ORIGINAL INK set the pace, weakened late in the third turn and flattened out in the stretch. PART PIRATE stalked the pace on the rail, raced evenly, bid three wide in the upper stretch but faded. ROLLETTI stalked the pace to the outside, weakened in the second turn, gave way and was eased.
