Footnotes

CAPTAIN FIESTA vied two wide, took the lead heading in to the backstretch, opened up and held well to the finish. DOCTOR PARK vied four wide, was three wide close up in the backstretch, made a three wide bid in the last turn and closed in. LUNAR LOOK saved ground, not far off the lead, slow gain on the rail, then three wide stretch drive to get up for show. EVER RINGING vied three wide, two wide close to pace, rallied between horses to gain the second position but was out run in the stretch. SPARK OF VALOR vied from the rail, stalked, but weakened after the half. DARK BRIAR saved ground, well off the pace, followed and showed little. RUM CHASER had a slow start, stayed on the rail well off the pace, trailed through out and was no factor.
