ZIP N' ZAP stalked the pace on the rail, gained ground steadily in the third turn, rallied three wide into the stretch, dueled with THE CASHEW QUEEN and prevailed. WEEKEND CEILIDH saved ground, raced evenly, rallied three wide into the stretch, closed well and got up for place. THE CASHEW QUEEN raced evenly to the outside, bid three wide in the backstretch, dueled gamely but was outfinished. BEAR INHERITANCE saved ground, raced evenly, rallied three wide into the stretch and finished well. LOOKONTHEBRITESIDE stalked the leaders, made a bid in the backstretch, dueled to the inside of THE CASHEW QUEEN but weakened in the upper stretch and faded. STONE JUSTICE was slow early, raced to the outside, entered the stretch four wide and gained ground. GLAD'S AND ROSE'S led early, weakened in the backstretch and dropped back steadily.
