RATTLE THE CAGE stalked the pace on the rail, made a bid at the five eighths pole, dueled to the outside, rallied and drew clear in mid stretch. FONDUE broke well, led early, dueled in the stretch but was outfinished. COUNTDOWN AT CAPE raced three wide early, moved to the rail in the backstretch, ran evenly, rallied three wide and gained ground. BO'S TIGER broke sharply, chased the pace, rallied in the upper stretch but weakened. HIGH BODGIT lacked speed, trailed early but gained ground in the backstretch, rallied four wide and finished evenly. SOUL BROTHER broke sharply, raced evenly on the rail and made a mild bid in the upper stretch. WILLYTHEBARBER got away slowly, trailed and made a mild rally. SALTON CHIEF stumbled at the start, raced three wide in the first turn, dropped back and trailed.
