KASHIN TIME stalked the pace on the rail, got through on the rail into the upper stretch, dueled and prevailed. WE TAUGHT ED lacked speed, raced evenly on the rail, closed along the rail in the second turn, swung three wide and closed fast to get up for place, BACK ALLY HAT was forced out entering the first turn, chased the leaders, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide, led but weakened in mid stretch. FEELING OLYMPIC raced evenly on the rail, rallied four wide and finished well. MARGARET'S ESTEEM set a pressured pace on the rail, opened a lead in the second turn but weakened in the upper stretch. ISLE OF VIEW pressed the pace to the outside but weakened in the second turn and dropped back in the stretch. OFFICER HAUS lacked speed, raced to the outside and was no factor. MY FRIEND TOM raced three wide into the first turn but weakened and chased the leaders in the backstretch but tired. PEPPERCORN had no speed and trailed.
