BENT TUNE broke well, stalked the pace, rallied four wide into the stretch and closed steadily. TURNAGAIN TAYLOR pressed the pace to the outside, opened a short lead in the upper stretch, ran gamely but was outfinished. KOOL ATLANTIC raced four wide early, trailed, got through in the upper stretch and finished evenly. WHAT'S UP DOC saved ground, raced evenly, rallied three wide but flattened out. CARDINAL ZIN was slow early, saved ground, rallied five wide and closed the gap. JACOBS KISS was slow early, raced evenly but trailed. LITTLE SLEW MOON saved ground set a pressured pace, led in the backstretch but faded in the stretch. BRED ROYAL stalked the pace, raced evenly, weakened in the second turn and faded in the stretch. PERFECTO CAT broke in the air, raced four wide into the first turn, raced evenly, rallied seven wide into the stretch and faded.
