BEST BE QUICK saved ground, advanced steadily, made a bid at the quarter pole and drew clear in the stretch. YANKEE COLONEL saved ground, raced evenly, gained ground in the backstretch, rallied into the stretch and got up for place. DISCO DAMSEL came in after the start and in the first turn, drew clear in the backstretch but weakened and tired in the stretch. POLAR was in tight on the rail in the first turn and was steady, gained ground but drifted out in the upper stretch and finished evenly. The trainer of POLAR claimed foul on DISCO DAMSEL for interference in the first turn. The claim of foul was upheld and DISCO DAMSEL was disqualified from third and placed fourth. WOKE UP LAUGHIN saved ground, raced evenly and was no threat. WIEST was in tight on the rail early and was taken back and saved ground. THANXFOREVERYTHING drifted out entering the first turn, raced evenly and was never a factor.
