Footnotes

SHADY MOOSE raced wide early, ran evenly, gained ground in the third turn, rally three wide and closed steadily. SOUL BROTHER set a pressured pace on the rail, rallied into the stretch but weakened in mid stretch and held place. VELVET FIRE raced evenly on the rail, gained ground steadily, rallied five wide and finished well. NOTIS THE CRIME raced evenly on the rail, gained ground in the backstretch, rallied in the upper stretch and finished evenly. GOLD SPEC saved ground, stalked the pace, rallied five wide into the stretch but flattened out. AWESOME A. J. pressed the pace, made a bid in the second turn but weakened in the upper stretch and faded. TEMPERED SPIRIT was taken back early, raced evenly and showed a mild rally. DIVINE DEED raced four wide early, moved to the rail in the backstretch and made a mild rally. PIER TWENTYONE dwelt then drifted and trailed. PEPPY LOCKE was caught six wide early, raced evenly but dropped back in the backstretch and trailed. THE 1 MILE FRACTIONAL TIME WAS HAND TIMED.
