GRAN KASEKI raced evenly on the rail, made a bid in the second turn, rallied into the stretch, got through on the rail late and got up at the wire. ALAWAY broke sharply, saved ground early, vied for the lead, led late but just failed. BOONSTOCK vied three wide, rallied into the upper stretch but was outfinished. ENOUGH EH saved ground, made a bid on the rail, vied for the rail the lead but weakened after the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. BIG O PUCK STOPPER was slow early, saved ground and made a mild rally. TOY TIGER stalked the pace on the rail, raced evenly and ly made a mild rally from three wide. POPPASICLE lacked early speed, ran evenly but was never a factor. BOLD AND WORTH IT lacked speed, trailed and passed tiring rivals. SOLID SLEWSHAN ran evenly to the outside and dropped back. P C'S RUCKUS raced four wide into the first turn, ran close up but weakened in the backstretch, dropped back and trailed.
