IT'S NOT OVER YET rushed to the lead, drew clear along the backstretch, rallied in the stretch and finished ridden out. AWESOME DEVIL raced evenly to the outside, gained ground in the second turn, rallied into the stretch and closed the gap. JIFFYJIMMYGEE was three wide early, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied in the stretch and gained late. CELTIC WARRIOR was slow early, raced evenly, rallied in the upper stretch and gained ground late. LEGAL CHILD was four wide early, stalked the pace, raced evenly but flattened out in the second turn. DEPUTY FUDGE saved ground, showed little. OUT CATTIN' saved ground, raced evenly while close up but weakened along the backstretch and dropped back steadily.
