Footnotes

ONE SO REGAL raced close up to the outside, bid three wide mid second turn, rallied in the upper stretch and drew clear in mid stretch. HEARTFROMTHESTART dueled to the outside of CRIMSON CHIEF, weakened in the upper stretch and held well for place. CRIMSON CHIEF dueled to the inside of HEARTFROMTHESTARTT, weakened in the upper stretch and faded. C R POWER broke outward, entered the first turn four wide, dropped back, gained ground in the third turn, rallied three wide into the stretch and gained late. MILES FROM DUBLIN was off slowly, saved ground and showed a mild rally. ALWAYSWANTMORE saved ground, raced evenly and was no factor. BEAR'S SAGA entered the first turn three wide, dropped back along the backstretch, showed a mild bid from three wide. IRONWOOD was three wide early, stalked the pace, raced evenly and weakened in the second turn and faded.
