Footnotes

BOULDER HAT raced three wide early, contended, gained ground in the second turn, bid three wide into the stretch and closed fast. OREN'S STAR saved ground, stalked the pace, made a bid along the rail in the backstretch, led into the stretch, weakened in mid stretch and finished second best. BENEZIT raced evenly to the outside, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide and chased in the stretch. BAD HAT lacked early speed, gained on the rail, swung three wide into the stretch but flattened out. KATAKING saved ground, raced evenly, rallied on the rail in the upper stretch and finished well. ELM CREEK lacked early speed, raced three wide into the first turn, gained ground rallied four wide and finished well. VINSEN ROSETTI no speed, trailed, mild rally. YARBO rail, dueled, weakened 1/4 pole, gave way steadily. TWOFOURTIME used early, entered the first turn three wide, contended but weakened in the backstretch. SCOOTER BUG rushed to contention, stalked the pace but weakened in the backstretch and gave way.
