Footnotes

SALSA EXPRESS stalked the pace, ran evenly, made a bid in the second turn, opened a lead in the upper stretch and drew clear. IN FORMATION lacked early speed, raced evenly, rallied into the upper stretch and finished second best. CALMCOOLNCCOLLECTED broke sharply, dueled on the rail but weakened after the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. CHATAHOOCHEIE saved ground, raced evenly and showed a mild rally. THE CAT'S AFFAIR raced evenly while three wide, failed to rally and faded in the stretch. CURLS AND PEARLS dueled to the outside but weakened in the second turn and gave way.
