SPARHAWK saved ground, dueled, led in the second turn, rallied into the upper stretch and held well. TWO POINT TONY dueled to the outside, weakened after the quarter pole, rallied and held place. PROJECT FIFTY FIVE raced close up on the rail, closed on the rail, rallied and closed the gap. BABS MOOSSA lacked speed, trailed, gained ground in the second turn, rallied and finished well. YANKEE COLONEL saved ground, stalked the pace but weakened in the backstretch and faded. MAD WIN got away alertly, vied on the rail, weakened in the second turn and dropped back in the stretch. HONEST BREW dropped back early, raced three wide, ran evenly and was no factor. PROSPECT BEGONIA lacked speed and trailed. RAINBOW STEW stalked wide early, dropped back and trailed.
