Footnotes

RIBBON CREEK raced evenly at the outside, gained ground in the third turn, rallied three wide and led in mid stretch. LOOKONTHEBRITESIDE raced between rivals early, bid three wide late in the backstretch, dueled, rallied and finished second best. SERVICE RIBBON lacked speed, raced three wide, gained ground steadily, rallied three wide but flattened out late. CEDAR FEVER saved ground, raced close up, ran evenly and showed a mild rally. SOUTHVIEW SARA was slow early, saved ground, rallied in the upper stretch and closed late. STONE JUSTICE raced evenly to the outside, gaining ground in the second turn, drifted out in the upper stretch and weakened. NEEDLESTICK dueled on the rail but weakened in the upper stretch and dropped back. TIME INCLUDED lacked speed, showed little. BRIARTIC BABE rushed to contention, entered the first turn three wide, vied for the lead but weakened at the three eighths pole and dropped back steadily
