Footnotes

FIRE THE LIMIT raced four wide into the first turn, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied four wide and closed ground steadily. FINTAN broke well but dropped back to the rail, rallied into the stretch and closed well. ONE FOR RED vied for the lead on the rail, dropped back but closed to get through on the rail in the stretch but faded. COUNTDOWN AT CAPE lacked speed and trailed, rallied into the upper stretch and finished well. BAD ARNOLD broke well and vied for the early lead from between rivals then dueled in the second turn but weakened in mid stretch and faded. HIGH TOWER was caught five wide in the first turn, gained ground to the outside, rallied three wide into the stretch but flattened out. GENERAL GABE raced three wide into the first turn, vied for the lead, raced evenly then dueled in the second turn but tired in the stretch. AGAIN AND GONE raced four wide into the first turn, stalked the pace to the outside then entered the stretch five wide and faded.
