UNCLERICHPEANUTS lacked early speed, gained ground three wide, rallied five wide and closed steadily. TIME FOR SLEWPY vied for the lead on the rail but weakened in mid stretch and held on for place. TWO C. C. vied for the lead from three wide, rallied in the upper stretch but was outfinished for place. SAINT'S ECHO saved ground early, gained ground but blocked through the upper stretch, altered course in mid stretch and closed well late. AUGUST RAIN raced close up to the outside, rallied four wide into the stretch and gained. LEROI'S WARNING stalked the pace on the rail, weakened after the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. SEXY ELEANOR broke sharply, vied for the lead from between rivals but weakened and tired in the stretch. SCRIPTOCAT saved ground, dropped back early and trailed.
